Red Deer County applies a nominal Library Levy to all assessed properties to cover the costs for provision of this service /membership.

★ Benefits to County Residents ★

- County residents can purchase memberships at any member library at an approximate cost of \$15 per year.
- Rural membership cards also have a special bar code that allows access to The Alberta Library (TAL) services.
- Rural membership cards with the TAL bar code are accepted at Red Deer Public Library where limited services are available.
