

ELECTRONICS EXPANSION PILOT PROJECT

Red Deer County is pleased to announce that we will be participating in the Electronics Expansion Pilot Project implemented by Alberta Recycling. The purpose of this two year pilot is to assess the implementation of a sustainable and expanded electronics recycling program by encouraging waste minimization in Alberta which will also support jobs and our economy during the Covid-19 recession. The program will also allow us to align with our neighboring provinces and expand our current electronics recycling program to allow more eligible materials. These materials will be residential items only, commercial and industrial items are not acceptable.
