A-Soo-Wuh-Um Park and the Joffre Bridge Day Use Area closed due to weather

Exercise precaution around waterways

(RED DEER COUNTY) Red Deer County is taking precaution and is temporarily closing A-Soo-Wuh-Um Park and the Joffre Bridge Day Use Area.

Current high volumes of swift moving and increased water river levels will be monitored in the areas. The parks will be reopened when there is less risk to the public. Red Deer County is actively monitoring the situation.

Earlier this week on June 13, 2022, Environment Canada and the River Forecast centre issued weather system and streamflow advisories: The Red Deer River has now been downgraded to a Flood Watch and Little Red Deer River remains on Flood Warning. For further information visit rivers.alberta.ca
